

The Brown County Public Library is continuing to closely monitor information about COVID-19 and adjust its services accordingly. The health and safety of our patrons and staff is our top priority as we strive to meet the information needs of our communities. In compliance with the Ohio Department of Health Stay-At-Home Order, effective Monday, March 23, 2020, at 4:00pm :

- All branches are closed to the public until April 7, 2020, or until the Stay-At-Home order is rescinded. Library operations will resume according to guidelines released by the State of Ohio or local health officials.
- All group programs and events are cancelled or postponed until further notice.
- Book drops are closed - please keep items until the dates listed below:
  - WiFi Hotspots are due on April 7
  - All other materials are due on April 20
- Fines accrued March 13-April 20 will be waived for all items except Wifi Hotspots
- Fines/other library account issues will not prohibit cardholders from using electronic resources
